

Zoom Online Class Expectations

Check your schedule.

Teachers will email the Private Zoom link to your parents or share it with you in Google Classroom

When you come onto Zoom please mute your microphone.

This is important because if everyone's volume is on that is a lot of voices trying to talk at once.

Arrive to class on time.

You may enter the "class" a couple minutes before your start time and wait in the waiting room for the class to begin. This is to ensure your technology is working properly before class time begins.

Attendance will be taken at the start of each meeting. You are required to remain for the entire meeting.

Be prepared.

Come to "class" with questions prepared. This is a time when you will be able to see your classmates, but this time is dedicated to questions or new material your teacher needs to go over with you.

Bring the necessary materials you will need for that class.

Example: Come to Math with your notebook open and a pencil handy!

Have your workbook for Social Studies; your workbook and notebook for religion.

Bring only those materials that are relevant to the class.

Attire

Wear school-appropriate attire—no hoodies, no costumes.

Follow the norms of the classroom.

Treat your classmates and teachers with kindness and respect.

All classroom rules apply to online classroom behavior. Remember your classroom intentions.

Behavior that interferes with a class will result in a student's removal from the meeting.
